Tracy Streeter has served as the Director of the Kansas Water Office, the state's water planning, policy and coordination agency since 2004. Tracy was re-appointed by Governor Sam Brownback on December 31, 2010. Before joining KWO, he served as Executive Director of the State Conservation Commission. Tracy began his career in Kansas water resources management in 1985.

Tracy serves as Chair of the Governor's Drought Response Team and the Kansas GIS policy Board. In addition, Tracy represents the State of Kansas on the Western States Water Council. In 2013, he was appointed by the Governor to lead the Water Vision Team with the Kansas Department of Agriculture in developing a 50 Year Vision for the Future of Water in Kansas.

A native Kansan, Tracy grew up on a diversified family farm in Brown County. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture and Agriculture Economics from Missouri Western State University and a Master of Public Administration degree from the University of Kansas.

Tracy served eight years on the Valley Falls Board of Education and is a private pilot.
