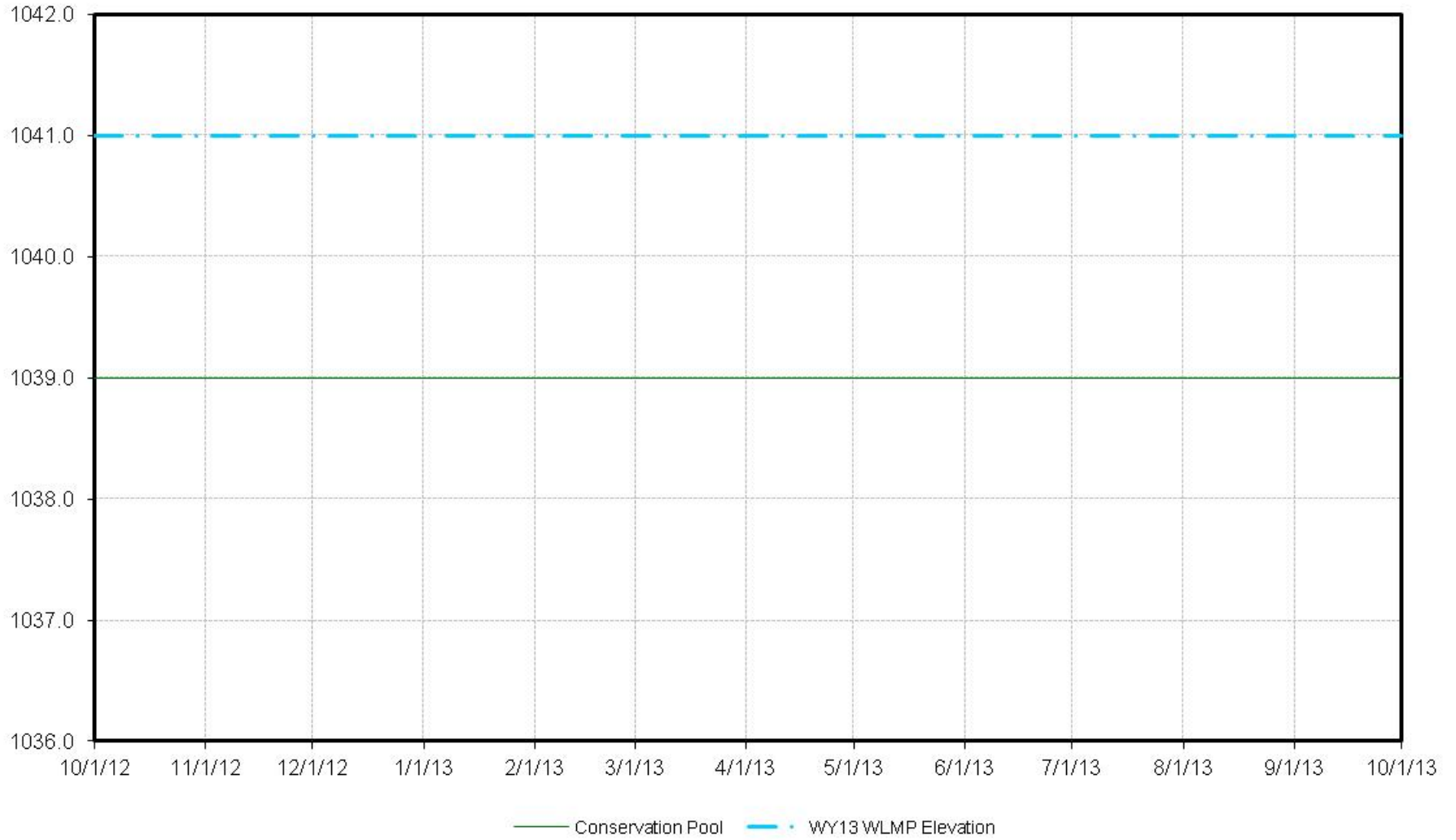


John Redmond Reservoir

JOHN REDMOND RESERVOIR

October 1 – September 30: A target elevation of 1041 will benefit the sport fishery. Increasing the depth will improve water quality, specifically, water clarity. Spawning habitat will also be enhanced and expanded.

Note: John Redmond is in a period of transition due to a reallocation and pool rise to 1041 to restore lost capacity from sedimentation. The reallocation process is expected to be complete in 2013. Future plans may include some target elevation fluctuation but will be developed after the completion of the reallocation. It is also important to note that, until the reallocation is complete, storage of inflows above elevation 1039 will not occur to the detriment of any downstream water right. Storage of inflows below 1039 will be only that which is not needed to satisfy senior downstream water rights and storage of inflows between 1039 and 1041 will be only that which is not necessary to satisfy all downstream water right demands.
