4. Regional Activities and Other Updates

- a. May KWA Meeting: Chair Martha Tasker as well as Ginger Harper (KWO) and Matt Unruh (KWO) provided an update on the proceedings of the May KWA meeting in Oakley.
- b. Blue Ribbon Funding Task Force Update: Ginger Harper provided an updated on the progress the Blue Ribbon Funding Task Force had made up to the time of the meeting. Information on the Blue Ribbon Funding Task Force can be found at <http://www.kwo.org/BlueRibbonTaskForce.html>.
- c. Regional Goal Action Plan Development Discussion: Matt Unruh facilitated discussion on Action Plan development for the Smoky Hill-Saline RAC. The focus of the conversation centered around Regional Goal #1. This goal reads as follows:

Increase available water supply, water supply storage, and interconnectivity among public water supplies within the Smoky Hill – Saline Planning Region. Methods of attaining goal can include: temporary or permanent conservation pool rise at Cedar Bluff Reservoir; utilize Wilson Reservoir as a water supply source for the region; permanent conservation pool rise at Kanopolis Reservoir; evaluate Kanopolis Reservoir to determine the feasibility of dredging and initiate project if deemed viable; construction of new water supply reservoirs within region; and phreatophyte control within riparian areas. Timeframe of implementation: Complete by 2060. Result of efforts: Ensure water supply available from reservoir storage exceeds demand by at least 10% through the year 2060.

Nathan Westrup (KWO), provided background information regarding Cedar Bluff and Kanopolis Reservoir. Following this discussion the RAC determined that the following action items should be included within the Action Plan for Regional Goal #1:

- Continue to pursue conservation pool rise efforts at Kanopolis Reservoir.
- Pursue alternative options to V-notch at Kanopolis Reservoir to allow for better control of operations and releases.
- Develop a lake level management plan at Cedar Bluff Reservoir to facilitate temporary pool rises on as needed basis when inflow conditions warrant.

5. Other Business

- a. Agency reports not previously discussed and Public Comments:
 - KDA-DWR: Kelly Stewart mentioned that the discussions regarding a Wilson Lake deviation request had quieted down recently.
 - KDA: Susan Metzger mentioned upcoming discussions to take place this fall regarding the WCA statute as well as the process for claiming impairment.
 - WRAPS:
 1. Ron Graber (KSU – Upper Lower Smoky Hill River WRAPS) discussed the recent tree revetment projects within the Upper Lower Smoky Hill River WRAPS project area and the pre and post evaluation of effectiveness studies of these sites.

2. Stacie Minson (KSU – Kanopolis WRAPS) discusses efforts to expand the scope of NWQI efforts upstream of the Town of Munjor HUC 12 to help facilitate additional BMP implementation within this area. She also discussed rain barrel efforts in Hays.
 - KWO: Ginger Harper mentioned the work of the Vision Education Task Force and their intent to get to future RAC meetings to inform RACs of the work that has taken place up to this point and to solicit input from the RACs.
 - NRCS: Dan Meyerhoff mentioned work gearing up for the next FFY as well as the upcoming Kansas Technical Committee meeting.
 - b. Questions and Future Issues from Members: There was discussion regarding the lack of attendance of several members of the RAC. There was general consensus that following the completion of the Regional Action Plans would be an appropriate time to pursue that lack of participation and work to refill positions if necessary.
 - c. Messages to the Kansas Water Authority: No formal messages were made to the Kansas Water Authority by the Smoky Hill-Saline RAC.

3. Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) Approval of January 2016 Meeting Notes: Brad Shogren made the motion to approve the January 2016 meeting notes, seconded by Allen Roth. The motion carried as presented

4. Regional Activities and Other Updates

- a. Regional Goal Action Plan Development Discussion: Ann D'Alfonso (KDHE) and Rachel Marlett (KDHE) presented information to the RAC regarding implementation costs for WRAPS 9 Element Watershed Plans within the Smoky Hill-Saline Planning Region (*see ATTACHMENT 1*). This included implementation cost estimates for the Cedar Bluff, Kanopolis, Upper Lower Smoky and Lower Lower Smoky WRAPS Projects.

Following the WRAPS information presented by KDHE, the RAC began work on development of a draft action plan for Smoky Hill-Saline Regional Planning Area - Vision Regional Goal #3. This goal is to “*Reduce sediment and total suspended solids (TSS) concentrations within the lakes and streams within the Smoky Hill – Saline Planning Region. Method of attaining goal can include the continued support of best management practice (BMP) implementation for practices which reduce sediment runoff. Focus BMP implementation within priority areas identified in Big Creek Middle Smoky Hill River Watersheds 9 Element Watershed Protection Plan. Timeframe of implementation: Complete by 2040 - Final year of 9 Element Watershed Protection Plan is 2034. Result of efforts: 26% reduction of TSS concentrations on the Smoky Hill River at Ellsworth as noted within the 9 Element Watershed Protection Plan. Remove sediment-impaired waters from the KDHE TMDL list.*”

Matt Unruh (KWO) presented a series of questions to the RAC to be answered by members present which would help serve as the basis for components of the action plan for Regional Goal #3. These questions were:

- What need to be done to implement this action plan?
- Who should take action to help implement this action plan?
- What technical/financial resources are needed in order to complete this action plan (Attempt to define dollar amount needed to implement action plan)?
- What is the timeframe for completion of this action item?
- Are there any areas within the Planning Area in which these actions will be focused (If so, identify these areas)?
- Are any regulation/policy changes or challenges needed to be addressed to most effectively implement this action plan (If so, define what these changes might be)?

Responses and feedback from RAC members were recorded by Matt. It was determined following the meeting Matt would compile the comments and feedback given by RAC members during the meeting and develop a draft action plan which the RAC would review at their next meeting and take action to finalize.

5. Other Business

- a. Agency reports not previously discussed and Public Comments:
- KDA-DWR: Mark Billinger provided a rules and regulation update. Rules and regulation changes discussed included development of an integrated stockwatering irrigation water right, lengthening of term permits for water conservation and integrated operations, defining the years to establish water use history, and consumptive use calculations.

 1. Jennifer Nichols mentioned efforts underway within the Bureau of Waste Management in the Old City Dump Cleanup Program. KDHE has a webmap application which can be used to view these dump locations as well as get facility information for an old dump of interest.
