



# Governor's Conference on the Future of Water in Kansas

November 8–9 | Manhattan, Kansas

## CALL FOR STUDENT POSTERS

Students are invited to submit abstracts on their water-related research to be presented as posters at the annual Governor's Conference on the Future of Water in Kansas Conference. Any research that involves water quantity, quality or water education is eligible. Posters will be presented throughout the morning of Day 2, November 9. It's good experience and a chance to network with University researchers, state agencies and private consultants. This conference is typically sold out with 600 attendees.

Students must register for the conference at student rate of \$25 for only Day 2, or they can register for the entire conference for \$50.

### **Student poster awards**

Students are interviewed and their research posters evaluated for the Governor's Outstanding Research Graduate or Undergraduate awards (a good award to add to resumes). Four cash awards will be given: top graduate (\$125), top undergraduate (\$125), and two runners-up (\$75). Judges (friendly ones) meet with students the morning of November 9. Award presentation will be made during lunch at the conference.

Monday, October 16, 4 p.m.: abstracts for posters submitted.

Monday, October 30, 4 p.m.: PDF or other image of draft posters submitted to coordinator.

Thursday, November 9, 8 a.m. posters set up, ready for judging.
